## **PREAMBLE**

Let it be known that this proposal is not a blueprint of control but of conviction. It restores the original American mission—to be a city upon a hill, a defender of liberty, a builder of peace, and a home for the soul of man.

We do not seek to reshape man to suit the government but to revive the government to protect man—his freedom, dignity, and faith.

## **CHAPTER I: A SPIRITUAL REAWAKENING**

### **Section 1. Restoration of National Morality**

- Require the placement of the Ten Commandments, the Declaration of Independence, and the Bill of Rights in every public school, courthouse, and civic building.
- Institute a National Day of Reflection (October 1st) to remember the spiritual heritage of the United States.

### **Section 2. Protect Religious Liberty**

- Ban digital surveillance of places of worship.
- Reinforce protections for private religious expression in schools and workplaces.

### **Section 3. The Faith & Freedom Initiative**

- Allocate \$3 billion in federal block grants for churches and religious charities that serve local communities.
- Offer tax incentives for businesses that partner with faith-based outreach programs to combat poverty and addiction.



## CHAPTER II: THE ECONOMIC COVENANT – OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL

### **Section 1. Revive American Industry**

- We should cut the federal corporate tax to 18% for companies that manufacture domestically and provide union-wage jobs.
- Launch “Made in America Zones” with tariff advantages and apprenticeship grants.

### **Section 2. Rebuild Our Infrastructure**

- Introduce a \$1.2 trillion national infrastructure package: railways, bridges, highways, broadband, and green energy projects—modeled after Eisenhower’s interstate highway plan.
- Launch the American Labor Corps—a civilian corps of 1 million jobs for construction, public works, and conservation.

### **Section 3. Restore the American Worker**

- Ban stock buybacks for companies receiving federal subsidies.
- Reinstate the Glass-Steagall firewall to separate commercial and investment banking.

### **Section 4. Tame the Giants**

- Break up the monopolies of Big Tech, Big Pharma, and financial institutions through antitrust enforcement.
- Create a Public Digital Commons to offer decentralized alternatives to major social platforms.



## CHAPTER III: A GOVERNMENT THAT SERVES, NOT CONTROLS

### **Section 1.** Sunset Clause for Federal Agencies

- Congress must reauthorize every 12 years every federal agency, or it will face automatic review and downsizing.

### **Section 2.** Transparency & Integrity

- Enact a Lobbying Sabbath: No lobbying or campaign donations during legislative sessions.
- A lifetime ban on Members of Congress becoming lobbyists.

### **Section 3.** Local First

- Shift 30% of federal programs to state-level implementation within five years, respecting subsidiarity and empowering local innovation.

## CHAPTER IV: A PEACE THROUGH STRENGTH DOCTRINE

### **Section 1.** Recommit to NATO & Democratic Alliances

- Strengthen partnerships against authoritarian aggression in Europe and Asia.
- Establish a Free Nations Cyber Defense Compact for democratic digital sovereignty.

### **Section 2.** Modernize the Arsenal of Democracy

- Invest in hypersonic and defensive space technology.
- Revive shipbuilding and aircraft production in American ports and cities.



### **Section 3. Dignity for the Uniform**

- Fully fund the VA and institute a Soldiers-to-Civil Servants transition program.
- End bureaucratic delays in benefits and care.

## **CHAPTER V: AMERICAN EDUCATION FOR THE 21ST CENTURY**

### **Section 1. Classical Core Curriculum**

- Implement a national standard for Civics, American History, Philosophy, and Financial Literacy rooted in constitutional values.
- Reinstate vocational and trade education as a national priority.

### **Section 2. The Teacher Corps**

- Create a national teaching corps with full benefits, housing assistance, and \$50,000 starting salaries for qualified educators.

### **Section 3. Parent Rights Amendment**

- Pass a federal statute affirming parents' right to direct their children's education, medical decisions, and spiritual upbringing.





## CHAPTER VI: CIVIL RIGHTS, CIVIL RESPONSIBILITY

### Section 1. Equal Justice, Equal Law

- National ban on no-knock raids except in hostage situations.
- Universal body-cam requirement for all law enforcement.

### Section 2. End the Culture War by Restoring Culture

- Ban federally funded programs promoting gender ideology or racial essentialism in public schools.
- Promote civic virtue through grants to community and arts organizations rooted in shared American values.

## CHAPTER VII: A CLIMATE OF STEWARDSHIP

### Section 1. National Conservation Corps

- Mobilize 500,000 young Americans for land, water, and forest restoration projects.

### Section 2. Clean Energy Challenge

- Invest in next-generation nuclear, hydropower, and clean hydrogen to complement our oil and natural gas.

### Section 3. American Resource Independence

- Permit domestic oil and gas exploration alongside mandatory clean-up and corporate reinvestment mandates.



## CHAPTER VIII: THE TECHNOLOGICAL CONSTITUTION

### **Section 1.** A Digital Bill of Rights

- Protect the right to anonymity, encryption, and due process online.
- Ban AI-based biometric surveillance without a warrant.

### **Section 2.** Data Ownership

- Grant full personal data ownership to individuals with opt-out rights from social media and tech platforms.

### **Section 3.** American AI Project

- Create a publicly accountable AI institute governed by a cross-disciplinary ethics board that ensures the ethical use of AI for medicine, education, and defense.



## FINAL PROVISIONS: THE NEW AMERICAN COVENANT

### **Section 1.** A Covenant of the Generations

Every newborn child in America shall receive a copy of the Constitution, the Bible, and a letter from the President reminding them of their inheritance of liberty.

### **Section 2.** A Memorial to Liberty

Construct a National Temple of the Republic in Washington, D.C.—a civic cathedral honoring our founding principles and inviting all citizens to remember their duty.
