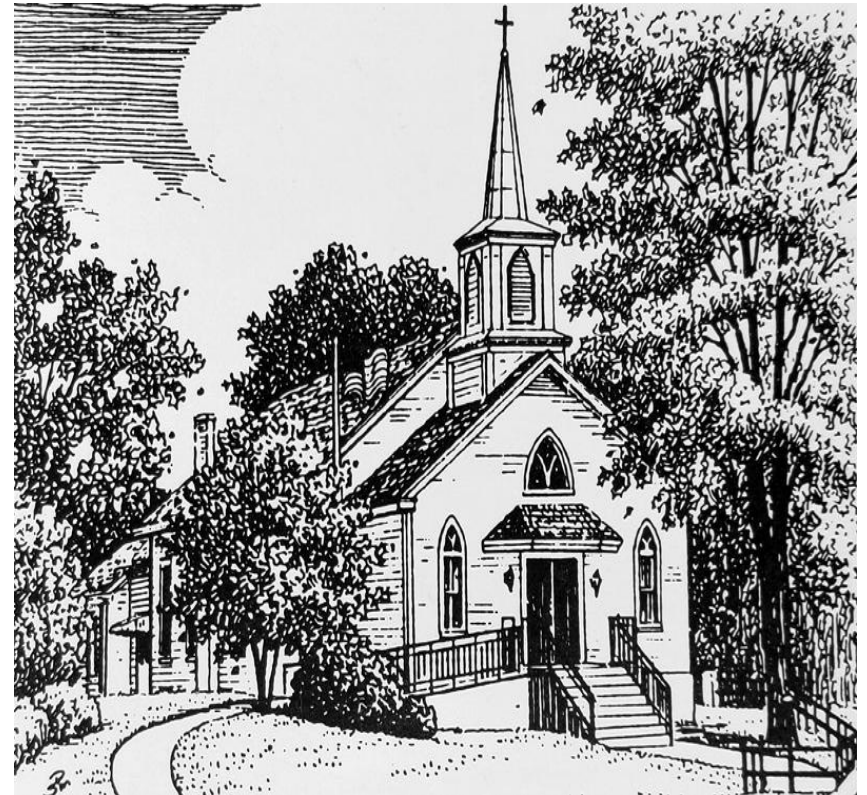
Today at 4:30 pm – Hymn sing with Soup & Sandwich supper at Bethel Church, 3716 Main St., Conestoga.
