Community

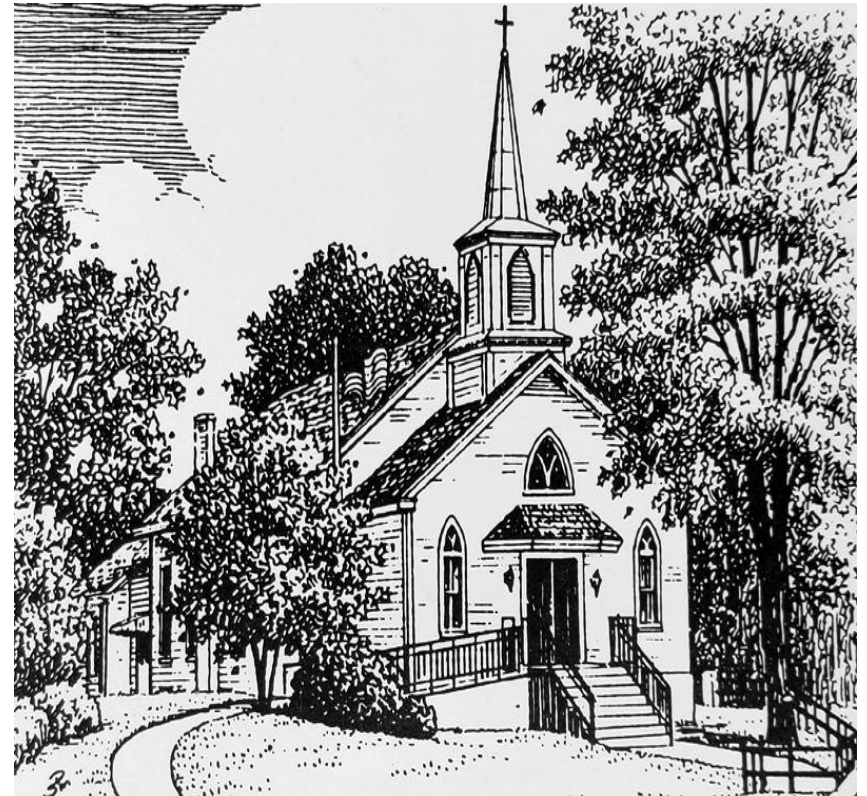
