Community

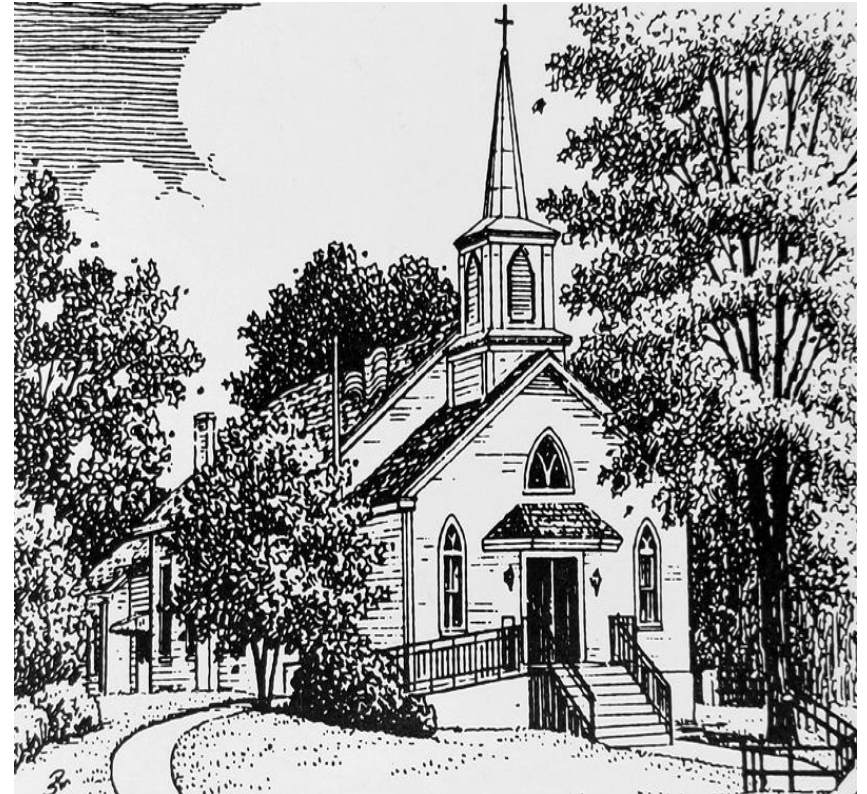
