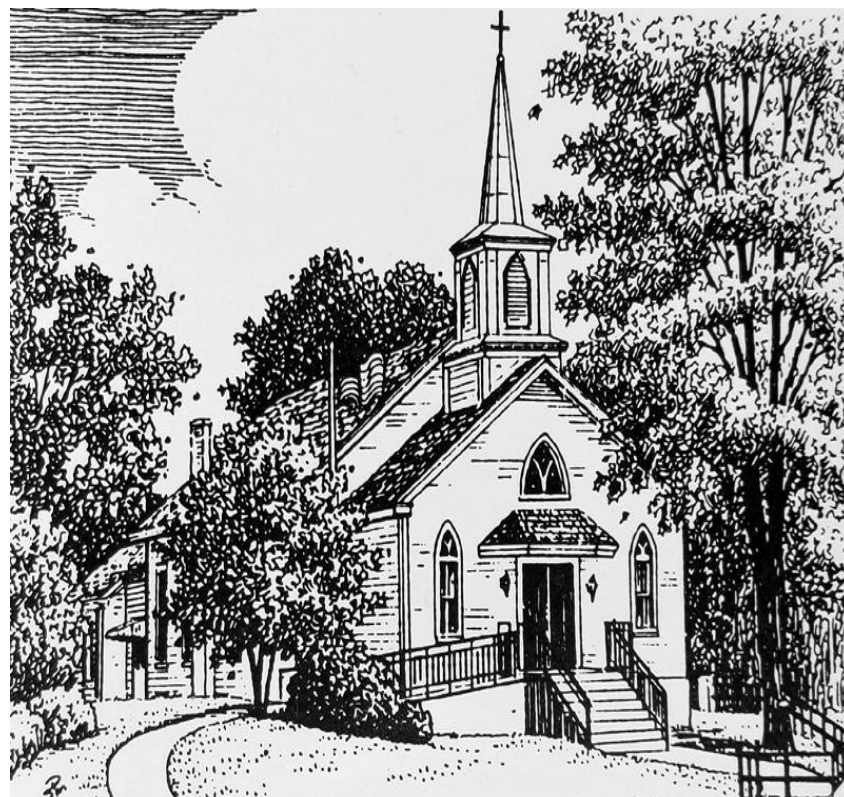
### **Community**
