HEAD COVERING UPDATE TO KITCHEN GUIDELINES EFFECTIVE

1-1-2026 - At the December UWF meeting, the following changes were discussed and are being implemented effective January 1, 2026.

Anyone working in the kitchen or with food must:

Wear a hairnet provided by the church, or a baseball-style cap provided by the individual. VISORS are NOT acceptable headwear.

Hair long enough to be tied back must be tied behind the head.

REMINDER -- Beard nets are available and required.

Please refer to the Kitchen Guidelines posted at the entrance to the kitchen area regarding policies and procedures for wearing gloves, aprons, handling food, food storage, etc.


