Greater Swiss Mountain Dog Club of America Draft Test Purpose

The Greater Swiss Mountain Dog Club of America (GSMDCA) Draft Tests are a series of standardized exercises through which Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs are judged at GSMDCA-sponsored draft tests in order to obtain GSMDCA drafting titles. The Greater Swiss Mountain Dog historically has functioned as a draft dog in various capacities. Accordingly, these exercises have been designed to reflect realistic work situations. Successful performance should demonstrate:

- The dog's inherent drafting ability refined by training and teamwork.
- The dog's readiness to work with his handler to accomplish the exercises efficiently.
- The dog's willingness and enjoyment of his work displayed by the combination of controlled-teamwork with his handler and natural independence.
- The handler's proper understanding of draft work, equipment and regulations.

Entry Information

The entry is limited to 12 teams of all classes per trial. In the event more than (12) entries are received, the Draft Test Chair will request a waiver to allow more teams to enter. Otherwise, entries are determined by the following priorities:

- 1) Priority will be given to entries that are untitled Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs
- 2) Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs that have earned titles in the class entered.
- 3) Untitled breeds, including brace teams with one Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs
- 4) Titled breeds, including brace teams with one Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs

A random draw will be held for each group that exceeds the test limit. Entries exceeding the total test limit will be assigned to an alternate list in the order in which they were drawn. Alternates may compete if a slot becomes available because a team is absent or unable to compete. In the event that a dog earns its title after the draw and continues showing in that class (does not "Move-Up" in the case of Novice), it will be moved to the end of the appropriate titled group. Entries close on Wednesday, November 30 at 5:00 PM (EST) at the Draft Test Secretary's snail mail or e-mail address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or altered, except as specifically allowed in the GSMDCA Draft Test regulations.

Awards

Each passing team will receive a ring prize and Qualifying ribbon provided by PGSMDC.

Refreshments & Lunch

Lunch will be provided for stewards, judges and other volunteers.

Additional Information

Definitions: The term "dog" applies to dogs of both sexes. The term "team" means a handler and his/her dog. All terms and instructions and regulations that refer to a single dog also apply to a pair of dogs working together unless otherwise noted.

- Entered dogs must be 18 months or older on the day of the draft test.
- Bitches in season are permitted to compete.
- No dogs belonging wholly or in part to the draft test judge, or to any member of their immediate family, may compete.
- The Basic Control Exercise shall be waived for dogs that have earned an AKC Companion Dog (CD) title if a copy of the CD title certificate is sent with the entry form. In the event the CD requirements were met, but the title certificate has not yet been received, the entrant may so state on the form and in a separate letter attached to the entry. If the dog passes the draft test, the NDD or DD title and certificate will be withheld until after the Draft Work Committee (DWC) Chairman receives a copy of the CD title certificate.
- Handlers must provide the draft rig. Any of the following draft rigs may be used: cart, wagon, sled, toboggan, or travois. Each of these must be equipped so that the draft rig cannot run up on the dog when hauling downhill.
- The handler selects and provides appropriate freight load for the apparatus and the dog.
- Entrants are responsible for obtaining the GSMDCA Draft Test Regulations dated May 2019 and being familiar with them. Regulations are available on the GSMDCA web site (www.gsmdca.org).
