SUMMONS

A lawsuit has been started against you in the above-entitled Court by Balkrishna Heroor, Plaintiff. Plaintiff's claims are stated in the written complaint, a copy of which is served upon you with this summons.

In order to defend against this lawsuit, you must respond to the complaint by stating your defense in writing and serving a copy upon the undersigned attorney for plaintiff within 20 days (or 60 days if you are served outside of the state of Washington) after the service of this summons, excluding the day of service, or a default judgment may be entered against you without notice. A default judgment is one where petitioners are entitled to what they ask for because you have not responded. If you serve a notice of appearance on the undersigned attorney, you are entitled to notice before a default judgment may be entered.

You may demand that petitioner file this lawsuit with the Court. If you do so, the demand must be in writing and must be served upon the person signing this summons. Within

1 14 days after you serve the demand, plaintiff must file this lawsuit with the Court, or the service
2 on you of the summons and complaint will be void.

3 If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this matter, you should do so promptly
4 so that your written response, if any, may be served on time.

5 This summons is issued pursuant to Rule 4 of the Superior Court Civil Rules of the
6 State of Washington.
