The Shield Lock (Chair Force)

This quarter, three HIMs of the Leroy and Kent AOs started a Shield Lock. A Shield Lock can look different depending on the HIMs involved, but Train, Gordito and Chair Force meet in the gloom every other week to "lock shields" by checking in with each other on burdens, picking up each other's six in life, setting personal goals and following up on them. The primary focus of Shield Lock is to facilitate a place for a deeper 3rd F and 2nd F. But we hit all three Fs—we start with a brutal 30-minute beatdown, and then over coffee we have a 3rd F discussion led by each HIM in a rotating fashion. We got together for lunch outside of our normal Shield Lock meeting just for fun, and we check in with each other and shoot the breeze almost daily about things serious and not serious. We hold each other accountable to being High Impact Men and encourage and help each other with it as well.

AO Defiance (Wrangler):

AO Defiance [from October-7 to December-30, Saturdays only] the Pax have done:

 - Goose (Florida), Big Sky (F3 Boise), Rat (Cascades Region Nantan), Frasier (F3 Chicago-Geneva)
- > Annual repeat beatdowns
 - o Amtrak's 'O My Gourd'
 - o Chad1000X

Pre-beatdown Challenges:

What do Amtrack, Hop King's shovel flag, and Gobbler Challenge have in common? Gobbler's creativity in designing the Gobbler Mile for Amtrak to recover the Hop King shovel flag.

- ¼ mile Over-Head Carry of Jerry-Can-filled-with-water
- ¼ mile farmers carry with a Jerry-Can-filled-with-water in each hand
- ½ mile 100-pound-Tombstone carry (sand filled)
- ¼ mile 120 pound carry (options were 120 pound sand bag, or ruck with 40 pound plate and an 80 pound sandbag

Amtrak set the mile record at 21 minutes, 16 seconds. Who's up for breaking the record in this challenge? Moreso, look well after the shovel flag.




AO Leroy (Train)

Our work must include creating an environment where a man, regardless of fitness, race, religion, or sexual orientation, has community and an opportunity to grow into his full potential. This potential serves his M, his family, and our greater South Sound community. It is an important moment for boys and men in the United States. Many young men lack positive role models, many older men are isolated and alone. A media narrative of the "end of men" and "toxic masculinity" leaves so many adult males uncertain of how to be in 2023 and beyond. Against this backdrop there has been a rise of white nationalist active clubs who market their groups for brotherhood, community, fitness, and self-defense. To the uninformed our group of men may not appear so dissimilar from extremist ideology groups that wish to further polarize our country. Men of F3 South Sound come from many backgrounds with varied political and religious beliefs. We are stronger together when our plurality stands as an example of our service to the five principles of our mission. Thank you to the men who model inclusion in F3 South Sound. Thank you to the men who model open dialogue. Be it through our partnerships, or the words we choose at our next beat down: Our work continues to build an inclusive network of high impact men invigorating male community leadership in the South Sound and beyond.
