Due to COVID 19 Pandemic, Inspire Equine Therapy Program was closed to services from March 16 to June 1, 2020. For the month of June, only 6 riding participants and one EFL program was able to participate with masks, social distancing and disinfection protocols in place. Inspire closed as scheduled to programming during July and August due to the heat. In September, independent riding participants and 2 EFL programs were able to return following strict COVID 19 protocols. In October, all programs, except for Stable Memories, were able to return following all protocols. Due to the increase in COVID spread in Pinellas County and Florida in general, Inspire closed to all programs November 23, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

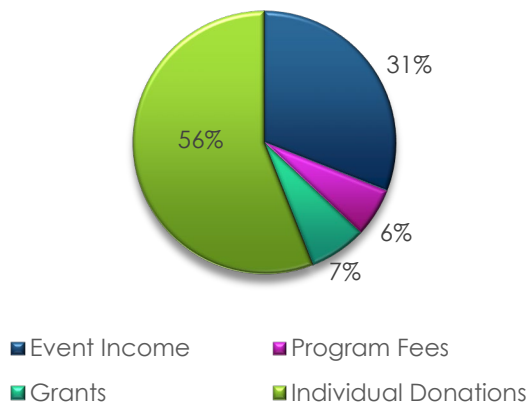
