Brothers and Friends of Salinas Lodge,








assistance, contact one of the officers who will help you connect. Its really quite easy. You just have to remember that you need to register beforehand.

- 3. You will be placed in a virtual waiting room until the WM lets you in.


#### You can also join by typing this link into your browser on your smart phone, tablet or computer: https://us02web.zoom.us/j/83477944778
