Prepraring for winter:

- Drip a faucet so pipes wont freeze or burst.
- Open the cabinets to allow the heat to circulate around the pipes.

Tips:

- RIDX in toilets monthly
- Change air filters monthly.
- Prevent unwanted pests by: Cleaning frequently, Putting trash out and stored correctly in trash cans.

Prepare emergency kit:

With winter weather approaching and uncertainties that lie ahead, better to prepare now than wait until it's too late.

You'll want to include the following basic items:

- 1. Flashlight with extra batteries
- 2. Basic First Aid items (Band-aids, Bandages, Aspirin, and Neosporin)
 - 3. Bottled Water
 - 4. Candles and Matches
 - 5. Car Charger for Cell Phones
 - 6. Manual Can Opener
