CAIRNS SAINTS FOOTBALL AND NETBALL CLUB PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES MAINTENANCE



Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure our children's playgrounds and associated equipment is well maintained, providing a safe and healthy environment for everyone at the club.

Objectives

The club will ensure:

- 1. The safety and wellbeing of all persons involved in utilising and visiting our playground and associated equipment.
- 2. To repsonsibly manage our playground equipment.
- 3. To comply with regulatory/licensing requirements regarding the playground equipment.

Principles

The club is committed to ensuring the regular maintenance of our playground equipment to ensure the health and safety of all our patrons.

This requires a commitment to the following:

- 1. The club will provide a rapid and efficient response to repairs with immediate priority given to matters likely to impact on the safety of children, families, staff and the public.
- 2. Planned programs will be developed to maintain the facility according to legislative requirements.
- 3. Programs will also be developed to upgrade the playground equipment to meet changes in legislative standards. These programs will include applications for grant funding and community fund-raising events to meet any financial commitments.
- 4. In conjunction with these plans, budgets will be developed and effectively co-ordinated to ensure the capacity to fund maintenance, repair and improvement programs annually.
- 5. We will undertake formal reviews of our processes and systems on a regular basis to monitor our effectiveness and develop specific improvement plans to address issues where required.

Responsibilities

All Club members, employees, players and volunteers are responsible for ensuring the safety of the playground equipment. It is vital that if any patron associated with the club identifies any issues with the playground equipment that may result in it being unsafe to use, actively report this issue to a member of the Management Committee.

The Management Committee will be responsible for ensuring the regular quality assurance checks and maintenance of the playground equipment. The Management Committee will appoint one member each year to conduct a regular maintenance check of the playground equipment as per the Playground Equipment Checklist.

Playground Maintenance Checklist

The Playground Maintenance Checklist is a guide to ensure the safety of the playground equipment and to identify any areas that may require maintenance. It is vital to ensure the maintenance of the playground equipment at the club is completed on a regular basis. For the purposes of this policy, this checklist should be completed twice a year.
