## **Team Guidelines:**

- Each team must complete and submit a BBQ Team Application, including contact information and the \$30 entry fee.
- Teams may consist of up to 4 members, including a designated head cook.
- All cooking must be completed on-site during competition hours.
- Teams must bring their own grills, smokers, utensils, and ingredients. Electricity will not be provided.

## **Food & Judging:**

- Entries must be cooked fresh on the day of the event—no pre-cooked meat allowed.
- Judging will be blind and based on the following criteria: taste, tenderness, appearance, and creativity.
- Each team must submit one sample plate for judging by Noon on Saturday, June 7th.

## **Set-Up & Clean-Up:**

- Set-up will be allowed on Friday, June 26th between 6:30 and 8pm. Any request for a time outside of this will be considered on a case-by-case basis and must be submitted in writing to [eventsdda@kingstondda.org](mailto:eventsdda@kingstondda.org) no later than May 30th.
- All team members must be on site by 10 am on Saturday June 27th, the official start time of the event.
- Cooking stations must be maintained in a clean and sanitary manner.
- Teams are responsible for removing all trash and supplies at the end of the competition.

## **Prizes & Recognition:**

- Prizes will be awarded for First, Second, and Third Place.
- Winners will be announced at 1:45pm the day of the event and will be recognized in post event promotional materials.

## **Other Considerations:**

- Alcohol is not permitted.

- All food must be prepared in accordance with local health and safety guidelines.
- The City of Kingston DDA reserves the right to adjust rules or disqualify teams for misconduct or violation of event policies.
