



- Make sure to have some kind of **color scheme**.
 - The main title and subtitles can be a different color compared to your information
 - Use **no more than 4 colors** per scheme
 - More than 4 colors can look bad
 - Make the color scheme relate to your topic
 - In the board above, the project was about solar energy so the color scheme used red, orange, and yellow.
- Make it as neat as possible!
 - Instead of using scissors you can probably use a **board paper cutter**. They are not very expensive and readily available in many stores. Look at the link below.

 - Instead of using only glue, you can also use **double sided tape**.
 - It gives the finished product a cleaner look and it is not very expensive either.
- **Choose correct fonts!**
 - Make sure the **font is actually readable**.
 - You probably don't want to use cursive.
 - Make sure that it is also **big enough** so that a judge doesn't have to get too close in order to read it and look at the tables and graphs.
 - You might want to use a font **bigger than size 18**.
