

Active & Passive Voice: Notes

What is active and passive voice?

- The voice or way a sentence is narrated
- Active Voice: sentence has a subject that acts upon its verb
- Passive Voice: subject is the recipient of a verb's action

How to identify active and passive voice?

- Look at the sentence and identify the subject, verb, and object
- If the subject does the action of the verb on the object, then it is active
- If the subject receives the action of the verb, then it is passive
 - Example: The girl ate the cake.
 - Subject: girl
 - Verb: ate
 - Object: cake
 - The girl is eating
 - The subject is doing the verb
 - This sentence is active.
 - Example: The question was answered by the student.
 - Subject: question
 - Verb: answered
 - Object: student
 - The is being answered
 - The action of the verb is done to the subject
 - This sentence is passive.
- Common Structure of Active Voice
 - Subject does Verb to Object.
- Common Structure of Passive Voice
 - Subject is being done to by the Verb from the Object.
