

Compound Words- When two single syllable words come together to form a word.

For example:

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steam + boat = steamboat
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- steam is a single syllable word, meaning this word has one <u>vowel team</u>, which is <u>ea</u>
- boat is a single syllable word, meaning this word also has one vowel team, which is oa
- When these two single syllable words are joined together, it forms a two syllable word or a compound word, steamboat.

Some helpful tips:

- Compound words have to be written together, there should not be any space between two words. steamboat (right way) steam boat(wrong way)
- Both words in a compound word should have their own meaning.
- Both words should support one another. Steamboat is a boat that is run by a steam engine.
