

#### Syllable means a vowel. A word can have:

- One syllable/vowel
- Two syllables/vowels
- Three syllables/vowels
- Multi syllables/vowels

### One syllable/vowel:

- Fresh: This word has one syllable/vowel which is e.
- Line:
  - 1. This word has one syllable/vowel only which is  $\underline{i}$ .
  - 2. Remember e is magic e which changes short vowel sound into long vowel sound.
- Dark: This word has one syllable/vowel which is ar.
- Train: This word has one syllable/vowel which is ai.
- Play, moat, doe, torch, turn, fir, fern, game, class

### Two syllables/vowels:

- sunset-This word has two syllables/vowels which are u and e.
- <u>inhale-This</u> word has two syllables/vowels which are <u>i</u> and <u>a</u>. Remember e is magic e which changes short vowel sound into long vowel sound.
- display-This word has two syllables/vowels which are i and ay.



### • Feedback, birthday,powder,flashlight,seesaw Three syllables/vowels:

- carpenter-This word has three syllables/vowels which are ar, e and er.
- windowpane-This word has three syllables/vowels which are i, ow and a. Remember e is magic e which changes short vowel sound into long vowel sound.
- afternoon-This word has three syllables/vowels which are a, er and oo.
- <u>elephant,lemonade,habitat,ladybug,instrument</u>

### Multi syllables/vowels:

- helicopter-This word has four syllables/vowels which are e, i, o and er.
- personality-This word has five syllables/vowels which are er, o, a, i, and y.
- responsibility-This word has six syllables/vowels which are  $\underline{e}$ ,  $\underline{o}$ ,  $\underline{i}$ ,  $\underline{i}$ ,  $\underline{i}$ ,  $\underline{y}$ .
- watermelon, responsibility, hippopotamus
