Polynomials and Factoring: Tips

- Always check your work when factoring!
 - When you have solved your factoring problem, check your work by distributing your answer again and solve it.
 - If the answer is the same as the beginning problem, then you are correct!
 - It is important to always check your work since you can easily make mistakes when factoring.
- Find a way of factoring that is more comfortable for you.
 - Some people like to write out each and every step and other people like to do it in their head.
 - Solve factoring problems in a way that best suits you.
- Be careful when performing operations on polynomials.
 - Make sure that the signs that you use to solve are correct.
 - Make sure that you have **distributed the terms in the correct** manner as well.
 - It is really easy to mess up operations such as subtraction and multiplication in polynomials.
