



Spanish: Tips

- **Accents** are very important in the Spanish language!
 - If you do not place an accent on a word, it can change the whole meaning of the same word
- Make sure that your **subjects and verbs agree!**
 - Most students make subject and verb agreement mistakes when speaking and writing in Spanish
 - Think about the subject and verb agreement in English and translate it into Spanish
 - If the subject is “he”, make the verb agree with the 3rd person singular
- Make sure to **learn your grammar!**
 - Grammar is definitely the most important aspect of any language
 - You need to make sure that you are comfortable with all the tenses and grammar concepts in order to be a fluent speaker
 - A good way to start in being a proficient Spanish speaker is to learn the tenses
- **Vocabulary matters!**
 - Most people don’t think vocabulary is important: They are WRONG!
 - You need to know the vocabulary in order to express your words nicely
 - You can’t just know tenses and grammar and not what how to use it
 - It is a good idea to learn important nouns and verbs found in the notes.
- Use the **grammar learned and apply it to your vocabulary.**
 - An easy way to become a master in Spanish, is to fully know your grammar and have the ability to adapt the vocabulary into it.
 - Most students struggle here! You are not alone!
 - Just review your grammar and vocabulary as often as possible!
