

Dear parent,

- The Private lessons dance agreement is similar to the normal lessons agreement where
 payment is still required for any absences including illness, however with private
 lessons there are 'no free' weeks for holidays as the room has been hired and paid for
 specifically for your child's lesson and is not re-sellable. (You will not be expected to pay
 for lessons when we are closed through natural Dance School Breaks).
- If we are closed for any reason and are unable to supply you with a lesson, then you will be informed as soon as possible and will not be charged.
- If your child is unable to make their lesson, then you are expected to contact Donna on 07928307107 as soon as possible and leave a message or text, so that she can contact the teacher and let them know not to expect the child for lesson. I will stress we are not in a position to make alternative arrangements for you, if you are unable to attend for any reason.
- When your child's teacher feels that your child is ready for competition, they will discuss
 the possibility with you and your child, as we appreciate that some parents only want
 these lessons for Technique & Exam purposes and not for competition.
- The competitions are typically March, July & October (however this is subject to change by the organisers). We normally attend the same competitions in the Birmingham & West Midlands, our competition children also take part in their own presentation show in November held locally, where they are given their certificates from the competitions they have attended.
