PSV Speed Limiter Penalty Failure to fit recommended speed limiters on a PSV engine or utility vehicle will be penalized under Rule 41A by a penalty of Ksh 10,000.

Penalty for PSVs with tinted windows Kenya's Highway Code 54A prohibits drivers from using PSVs with tinted windows or windshields. If you are caught breaking this rule, you will be fined 2000 Ks. Driving Without a Fire Extinguisher and Fire Extinguisher Kit - NNTSA Requirement for Private Vehicles Kenya Traffic Regulations No. 25 requires all vehicles to be fitted with reflective warning signs, also known as rescuer failure, resulting in a Ksh2,000 fine. NNTSA Fines for Matusi Gates Kenya's NNTSA Traffic has issued 80 rules to penalize drivers who frequently drive out of PSV gates, stating that anyone driving outside with a part of their body must pay Ksh1,000. OK According to Kenya Road Traffic Act No. 103(1)is not closed. To put an end to reckless driving in Kenya, the NNTSA Fines PDF contains specific seat belt guidelines. If you own a PSV vehicle and do not wear a seat belt, you as the vehicle owner must pay Ksh 1,000 for each seat without a seat belt under NNTSA 22A Traffic Rules (1 & 2). Meanwhile, the driver of a PSV must wear a seat belt at all times to ensure he is buckled or face a Ksh500 fine under Section 22A (5 and 6) of the Highway Code. . The fine for driving without car insurance in Kenya can be up to Ksh 100,000 or a year in prison if caught. NNTSA penalty for driving without registration. Section 7 of the Road Traffic Act 12(1) and (14) makes driving without number plates or false registration a criminal offense punishable by a fine of Kshs 10,000. Meanwhile, Article 130C(1) and (3) prohibit VSP drivers from allowing strangers to drive their vehicle; otherwise they pay a fine of 5,000 Ksh. NNTSA Penalty for Driving Without a Valid MOT Do not drive a vehicle without a valid MOT as it is illegal and subject to a fine of Ksh 10,000 for Section 16(2) and Section 17A(3) violations. The new Traffic Code 30 (1) and (7) prohibits driving a vehicle without a license for a certain class of vehicle. If caught, you will have to pay a fine of Ksh 7,000. On the other hand, paragraphs 4 and 41 of Article 30 provide that the driving license must be renewed.will be fined up to 25,000 shillings if they breach the new 50km/h speed limit for CBD-bound vehicles. Speeds will be monitored following the installation of new cameras in accordance with the NNTSA speed limit notice set out in the Highway Code Handbook. The camera installation process starts at City Cabanas at KWS Gate to Langaata Road, Mombasa Road, Nakumatt-ong-Ngong Road Junction and from Nakumatt Junction to Uthuru to Naivasha Road. The speed limit starts at the intersection of James Gichuru Road to Waiyaki Way, Mobile Service Station Peponie Road and Mutaiga Shop Limuru Road. On the Northern Circular Road, this enforcement starts at the Nyayo-Barracks roundabout and from Ridgeways to Kimaboo Road. Authorities said motorists traveling on Kangundo Road will obey the speed limits on Kangundo Road and Uthalia Drift on Thika Road.
