## Morris 8 Ball Pool League 2024-2025 Season Welcome to all Players!

Start Date: Thursday October 17, 2024 – All matches are Thursday night matches

Please be courteous and flexible of other teams if they need to switch nights.

Start Time: 7:00pm – If none of the players from one of the teams is not present by 7:15, that team will lose a match every 10 minutes until someone is present. Total forfeit is at 8:00pm. Call if you need a later start time. Matches must be made up from 1st half before we start 2nd time thru or it will be split, matches from 2nd time thru must be made up by last night of scheduled league play or will be split. Matches need to be made up in a reasonable amount of time

Cost is \$10.00 a player (RACK YOUR OWN RACK) \$24.00 to play pool, \$56.00 in envelope \$1.00 per player per night will go towards year end tournament

You will play every team twice. Teams will be ranked by rounds won and paybacks on total points You can email a picture of your score sheet to <u>leagues@gamesunlimitedinc.com</u> or send a picture to 605 -949-2976 and then mail it with the money.

If you played last year then use that handicap for first 8 matches you play no matter what week you start playing, then switch to current stats, new players will have to figure handicap after the match is over.

10 – 7 scoring system. A win is always 10 points and loser of match gets 1 point for each ball pocketed. Each round is worth 1 point, total points is worth 1 point, for a total of 5 round point wins. On team averages whichever team has the lower team average gets the extra points, does not matter where they are in team standings. Lowest handicap a player can be is 5.

Handicaps are fractioned, to figure team handicap use the full handicap of all 4 players, don't round up or down on individual players, add all 4 together then either go up or down. Example: 9.25 + 8.21 + 7.56 + 7.54 = 32.56, which would be a team average of 33. Determine the difference to see which team gets team handicap points.

If the object ball you are shooting at is the 8 ball and you scratch and do not make the 8 ball it is just a foul – ball in hand – not loss of game. If you make the 8ball and scratch then it is loss of game

Be courteous of other players and do not be on your cell phone when you are playing a match Ball in hand rules, no patch on 8 ball shot just make sure and call your pocket No coaching or time outs. Be courteous on length of time a shot takes, keep the game going. Roaming subs are allowed, play around a late player – 4 regular players & 6 subs per team Will take the week of Nov. 28th and Dec. 26th off

Must have 3 nights of play with the same team for yearend tournament -2 week pre-registration -1 division Once a team is beaten out, Players CAN NOT rejoin another team. No subbing in players during a match, the 4 players that start a match must finish the match. Higher seed team will be the home team, No flipping for home Must play on 2 tables when available, the team on the hill can choose to stay and finish the tournament or go back to home location the following Thursday and finish the matches

Year-end – 2 weeks of tournament play Thurs. April 3rd & 10th, at as many locations as possible Final Rounds Saturday April 12th @ Spaulding's Sports Bar 9:00am Sharp Start Time
