### The Conclusion as written by Snehi Mehta

The United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime as a committee has extensively discussed the agenda of steps to curb emergence and growth of organized crime groups in Latin America. The committee has discussed elaborate statistics regarding the various types of organized crimes present not only in the Latin American region but all around the world. With a highly entertaining blame game between Mexico and USA on the first day to the sudden change of heart by USA claiming that it did not wish to blame anyone in particular on the second day, the third day was concentrated around finding a solution.

On the last day the discussions were centered on finding the solutions to the problem stated in the agenda. Cuba had admitted to the fact that human trafficking is done actively in their country mainly due to one reason the weakening of their political system. Cuba empathized with the victims of human trafficking and urged the countries to help rehabilitate the victims instead of punishing them for being a part of this heinous crime.

Myanmar gave a speech educating the committee about the various methods adopted by them to curb the transportation on illegal drugs and narcotics. Myanmar has monitored the transport of chemicals in and out of the country, it has prohibited the planting of illegal drugs and has agreed to monitor the indicators of human trafficking.

Japan reminded the committee that there have been a lot of solutions previously proposed in the committee but they were not implemented by the countries. The reason for the weak implementation was stated as the weakness of the rule of law in the countries.

Argentina and Spain proposed a document including an overview of the probable recommendations to be given as a conclusion to the discussion carried out through the span of three days for all countries to discuss upon. There was a considerable amount of questions raised by several countries regarding the ambiguity in the solutions which were promised to be clarified in the draft resolution.
