# PRE-EMPLOYMENT TRANSITION SERVICES









- The Pre-ETS Program continues to serve 8 schools in Burke, McDowell and Rutherford counties.
- We are now serving over 230 students in 8 schools with 8 instructors.
- We provide Job Exploration Counseling, Work-Based Learning Experience, Workplace Readiness Training, Instruction in Self-Advocacy and Counseling on education beyond high school.
- Instructors continue to participating in the IEP meetings with their students.
- Instructors continue to connect with local colleges such as Isothermal, Western Piedmont and McDowell Technical Community Colleges for tours and guest speakers.
- Students have been participating in job shadowing, job sampling, and paid work activities at places such as Corinth Baptist Church, United Methodist Church Meals on Wheels, and Second Harvest Food Bank.
- Draughn Pre-ETS program hosted a Scavenger Hunt with essential careerbuilding themes and a Gart Ogle as a special speaker.




