Activity Punch Cards are \$20. This is good for 10 activities and saves you \$1 per activity.

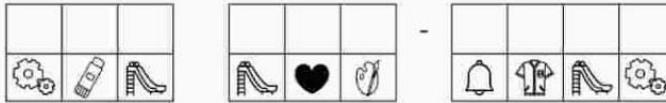
LUNCH PUNCH CARDS

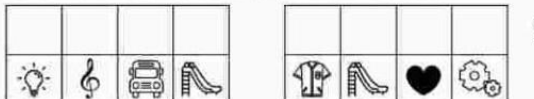
SCHOOL JOKES CODE BREAKER Use the key to break the code.

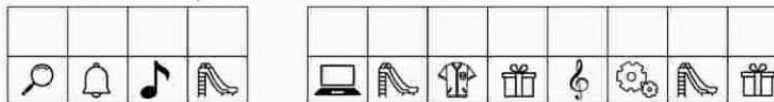
1. What do elves learn in school?



2. What did the zero say to the eight?



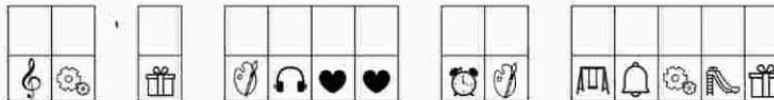
