Pre Listing To Do List

\Box Enhance curb appeal: tidy the yard, trim plants, plant flowers and repaint or clean the front door so the exterior looks welcoming.
\Box Declutter and depersonalize: clear surfaces, closets and storage areas; pack away personal photos, collections and bold decor so buyers can imagine themselves in the home.
\Box Complete repairs and maintenance: tighten loose handles, replace burned out bulbs, patch walls, fix dripping faucets, clean gutters and service mechanical systems.
☐ Deep clean and neutralize: scrub every room from baseboards to bathrooms, steam clean carpets, neutralize odors and repaint brightly colored walls with neutral colors.
\Box Price and present wisely: consult a local real estate professional to set a realistic price and invest in professional photos, staging and marketing to showcase your home.
\Box Hide valuables and secure items: lock up jewelry, art and important documents during showings and open houses.
\Box Gather documents: assemble warranties, permits, receipts and utility bills to answer buyer questions and build trust during negotiations.
\Box Prepare for showings: have a plan for pets, leave lights on, open blinds and keep the home ready for last minute tours.
