The laboratory, utilities (including all associated monthly costs), accessories, and all equipment required by the contract requirements including furnishing of a laboratory site shall be included in the unit price bid for mobilization or applicable bid item for quality control sampling, testing, and inspection as reflected in the bid schedule.

c. **Scope of Work consists of:** The N8066(3)1,2&4 project consists of grading and roadway excavation; placement of aggregate base course and asphalt pavement; installation of drainage structures, including a precast concrete arch culvert; and construction of fencing, cattleguards, gates, signage, striping, and other miscellaneous work as outlined in the design plans and specifications. The project spans approximately 6.92 miles within the Black Mesa area of Navajo County, Arizona, on the Navajo Nation. All work shall be completed in accordance with the project plans, the *Standard Specifications for Construction of Roads and Bridges on Federal Highway Projects (FP-14)*, and the applicable Special Contract Requirements. This project is funded through the Tribal Transportation Program



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administered by the Federal Highway Administration and must comply with all applicable federal regulations and requirements. In total, there are eight waterline crossings that will require relocation and/or encasement in accordance with current NTUA Water Design Standards and Details. These activities will be coordinated by NTUA (Jeremy Bitsoi and district staff) in collaboration with the Navajo DOT Contractor, including construction preparation, materials, inspection, and acceptance. While some waterlines have existing steel encasements or will be abandoned, the majority will be relocated and encased by NDOT. The Contractor will also be responsible for installing NTUA-furnished waterline marker posts under the specified bid item. Additionally, one sewer line within the project area has been identified and will be protected in place during construction, as it does not conflict with the proposed improvements.

b. NTUA power – For the N8066 mainline and spur, NTUA electric facilities are present within the project area but were verified through field survey to meet minimum vertical clearance requirements and do not conflict with the proposed improvements; therefore, they will be protected in place. However, within the Chapter House access road and parking area, existing powerlines and poles do present a conflict. If this portion of the project is included as an add alternate, Navajo DOT will coordinate with NTUA to complete the necessary relocations, with associated costs to be paid by the Contractor under Item 64503-1000.

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- a. *Is there a water source in the area? Contractor will be responsible for contacting the Navajo Nation Technical, Construction and Operations Branch (NNTCOB) to request a suitable water source location for construction water. A Water Use Permit will need to be filled out by the Contractor and approved by the NNTCOB. There is the potential that the Contractor will have to haul construction water to the site from an approved water source location.*
- b. *Is there an anticipated start date? August 2026 (subject to approvals).*
- c. *What role will the Black Mesa Chapter have for the project? The Chapter will be kept informed of project progress during construction and is welcome to attend the construction progress meetings. Contractors could possibly contact the Chapter regarding the use of space for a construction yard in the Chapter House boundaries. 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maintain access to existing residential turnouts and along the main roadway during construction.
