AUTHORITY:

Attachment A is to be appended to the Master Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA), MOU 254, for road maintenance and improvement projects between the Navajo Nation (NATION) and Sandoval County, New Mexico (COUNTY) as contemplated in Sections 1. Purpose, and 1.A Funding for Projects of the Master IGA.

SCOPE OF WORK

Routine Maintenance on Various Tribal Routes in the Eastern Agency

Routine maintenance activities of various Tribal, BIA and County routes located in the Eastern Agency within the Counselor, Ojo Encino and Torreon Chapters of the Navajo Nation. The roads were designated by Navajo DOT as routes that should receive routine quarterly maintenance. Road maintenance services may include, but not limited to, blading, snow/ice removal, reconditioning roadway surface, clear ditch lines, road reconnaissance for any maintenance needs, culvert replacements and any other needed maintenance activities, to provide an adequate network of roads for residents and visitors.

Payment to the COUNTY:

Per section 5.A. of the Master IGA, the NATION shall provide the COUNTY **\$200,000.00** in funding for the PROJECT. This funding shall be placed in an account established by the COUNTY and will be utilized for the work described in the Scope of Work of this Attachment.

Upon mutual agreement of both parties, project termini may be altered that fall within the same scope as described in this attachment. **Altered PROJECTS would commence once upfront/startup funding has been received by the COUNTY unless there is sufficient funding remaining from the initial payment to the COUNTY.**
