How?

For those who are not familiar with the makeup of our organizations, here's a little background. There are actually two completely separate Republican groups within Summit County, Colorado.



Summit County Republican Women

We are under the auspices of the Colorado Federation of Republican Women and National Federation of Republican Women. Our goal is to build relationships among like-minded women and strengthen our knowledge of local and national politics, our community, schools, and the environment.

As stated in our bylaws, any women registered as a Republican can become a member. Dues are \$40 per year (\$35 for early-bird memberships prior to December 31, 2024). If you are a Republican woman affiliated as a regular member of another women's group, you can join as an associate member (\$20). Republican men may also join as associate members. Associate members are non-voting.

For 2025, our elected officers are: President, Debra Irvine; Vice-President, Becky Foote; Secretary, Barb Tabb; Treasurer, Sue Todd. Committee Chairs: Parliamentarian/Bylaws, Jeanne Oltman; Programming and Facilitation, Debra Irvine; Social Media and Internal Communications, Barbara Peterson; Americanism and Scholarship, Becky Foote; Membership, Penny TerHaar; Marketing and Public Relations, Jini Clare.

A few of our SCRW accomplishments this past year

Bummit County Republican Central Committee

The Summit County Republican Central Committee (SCRCC) is governed by a set of bylaws which are in keeping with the Colorado Republican Committee bylaws and the rules of the Colorado Secretary of State. Precinct Committee members are elected by their registered Republican peers at the County Caucus held every two years.

The SCRCC elects its Executive Committee in the odd-numbered years: comprised of a chair, vice chair, treasurer and secretary.

Central Committee Precinct Committee persons (registered Republicans in Summit County) represent their precinct voters in the SCRCC. We have 20 precincts in Summit County.

Duties typically include:

Attendance at SCRCC meetings; Distribution of REPUBLICAN nominee literature/lawn signs; recruiting and mobilizing volunteers in connection with REPUBLICAN voter registration and REPUBLICAN GOTV (get-out-the-vote) activities of the Republican Party.

The Summit County Republican Central Committee organizes an annual Lincoln Day Dinner and other events to raise money for Republican candidates.
