LOCATION OF THE VINEYARDS	Arruda dos Vinhos, Portugal. Mostly hillside vineyards.
CLIMATE	Mediterranean with a strong Atlantic influence.
SOIL	Clay-limestone.
GRAPES	Cabernet Sauvignon and Alicante Bouschet.
VINIFICATION	Automatic wine press followed by fermentation in stainless steel vats. Partial aging for 12 to 18 months in French oak barrels.
TASTING NOTES	Garnet colour, expressive aroma with black fruit, pepper and some complex notes of truffle in perfect harmony with the toast of the oak. In the mouth it is concentrated, fresh and elegant.
CONSUMPTION SUGGESTION	It goes well with red meat dishes, sausages and game.
TEMPERATURE	Serve at 16-18°C Alcohol Content 13,5%vol Total Acidity 5,25g/l PH 3,50
