Quinta de S. Sebastião is located in a small town north of Lisbon called Arruda dos Vinhos, one of the sub-regions of the main region of Lisbon. Arruda dos Vinhos has a tradition of winemaking for over 1.000 years. The vineyards are located on the same hills of "Forte do Cego", which an old military fortification. "Forte do Cego", which was first called "Forte de S. Sebastião" (because of the Quinta), was part of a line of fortifications, called "Linhas de Torres", that played a crucial role in defending Lisbon against the French invasions led by Napoléon Bonaparte.
