READING OF THE LAW*

As the Lord, Jesus reveals his will for those that belong to his Kingdom. In turn, we recognize our sin and respond with confession

ROMANS 12:1-2

LEADER I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

HEIDELBERG CATECHISM

QUESTION 124

LEADER What is the third petition [of The Lord's Prayer]?

ALL "Your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven;" that is, grant that we and all men renounce our own will, and without disputing obey Your will, which alone is good; so that everyone may fulfill his office and calling as willingly and faithfully as the angels do in heaven.

Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."
