WESTMINSTER SHORTER CATECHISM

QUESTION 105

LEADER What do we pray for in the fifth petition [of The Lord's Prayer]?

ALL In the fifth petition, which is "And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors," we pray that God, for Christ's sake, would freely pardon all our sins. We are the especially encouraged to ask for this because we are enabled by his grace to forgive others from the heart.

CORPORATE AND INDIVIDUAL CONFESSION

We pray with full confidence that our holy God is merciful to sinners because of Jesus Christ

ALL Heavenly Father, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. Forgive us for holding on to grudges, for seeking revenge instead of reconciliation, and for failing to extend grace to others. Help us to know not only the depths of our sin but also the unsearchable riches of your grace. By your Spirit, give us the strength we need to forgive others and to forbear the everyday grievances of life. Remind us that we have been forgiven through our Lord Jesus Christ, in whose name we pray, Amen.



THE LORD'S SUPPER

1 CORINTHIANS 11:23-26

For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

sacrament instituted by God
and to be shared only by
baptized believers who are
members in good standing of
a local church
