2 PETER 4:7-11

LEADER The end of all things is at hand; therefore be self-controlled and sober-minded for the sake of your prayers. WESTMINSTER SHORTER CATECHISM 107

LEADER What does the conclusion of the Lord's prayer teach us?

ALL The conclusion of the Lord's prayer (for yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever) teaches us to be encouraged only by God in our prayers and to praise Him by acknowledging that kingdom, power, and glory are His. 1 CORINTHIANS 11:23-26
