Dan Adams, treasurer, reported the club currently has approximately \$19,500 balance, which is comparative to the balance at this time last year. Our membership dues is primary source of funding for the club.

Shelly Moorman, trustee, gave update on the success of the Youthfest, held Aug.3,

Paul Renfro gave update on the Jr Rifle club. The 1st meeting of the current session on Thursday nights had 13 of 14 available attendee slots filled. If there are more than 14 attendees signing up he will need to add a Sunday session.
