MERCER COUNTY SPORTSMEN'S ASSOCIATION ARCHERY RANGE RULES

BEFORE USING RANGE, READ AND FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH ALL RULES

- 1. BE SAFE, OBSERVE ALL RULES AT ALL TIMES AND BE COURTEOUS TO YOUR FELLOW ARCHERS.
- 2. SHOOTING HOURS ARE SUNRISE TO SUNSET.
- 3. ARCHERY RANGE IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC ON THE 2ND SUNDAY OF EACH MONTH.
- 4. SHOOTERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO USE SAFETY EQUIPMENT SUCH AS EYE, ARM, AND FINGER PROTECTION. LONG HAIR, JEWELRY AND STRINGS ON CLOTHING SHOULD BE TIED BACK. FAILURE TO DO SO IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SHOOTER.
- 5. CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT.
- 6. SHOOT FROM DESIGNATED SHOOTING POSITONS ONLY.
- 7. DO NOT GO DOWN RANGE TO RETRIEVE ARROWS UNTIL ALL SHOOTERS HAVE ACKNOWLEDGED "CEASE FIRE" AND ALL BOWS HAVE BEEN HUNG UP.
- 8. DO NOT COCK CROSSBOW UNTIL READY TO SHOOT.
- 9. WHEN GOING TO RETRIEVE ARROWS, HANG BOW ON POST AT SHOOTING POSITION.
- 10. DO NOT SHOOT AT A TARGET IF A BOW IS HANGING ON POST AT SHOOTING POSITIONS, AS THAT MIGHT INDICATE SOMEONE IS DOWN RANGE.
- 11. BROAD HEADS ARE ALLOWED ON PERSONAL TARGETS ONLY.
- 12. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PERMITTED ON THE RANGE. DO NOT HANDLE BOWS OR CROSSBOWS IF YOU ARE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS.
- 13. FAILURE TO FOLLOW RANGE RULES OR UNSAFE BEHAVIOR MAY RESULT IN PERON(S) BEING BANNED FROM RANGE AND / OR LOSS OF CLUB MEMBERSHIP.
