VEHICLE GATE ACCESS

1. MEMBER & AUTHORIZED USER RESPONSIBILITY & ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:

By using the electronic gate system, members and/or authorized facility/grounds users accept total responsibility for any injury or damage that may result to their vehicle, themselves, other members, guests, and the gate system.

2. WARNING

Each card held to card sensor or exit sensor activation by a vehicle allows pass thru of (1) vehicle and identifies the member or authorized user group. Protecting membership privileges and/or authorized facility use is so important that permitting more than one vehicle to enter or exit under a single card presentation or vehicle sensor activation may result in suspension of gate access privileges and/or termination of association membership of all parties involved, as determined by the Board of Trustees.

3. Gate Operation:

Gate swings inward and cannot be manually forced in either direction without causing serious damage to opener. Members or authorized users may be charged the full cost of repair or replacement for damages to the gate system occurring during their use.

Each time members card is held to entry sensor or exit sensor activation by vehicle allows pass thru of (1) vehicle and identifies the member or authorized user group.

3. a.

If you arrive at the gate area and the gate is in motion or open, wait until the gate is fully closed before holding your entry card to the sensor or before driving into exit sensor to leave MCSA grounds.

Gate is equipped with sensor(s) that close gate automatically following your entry, opens gate as you approach reflectors/signs when exiting, then closes the gate.

4. Entry/access:

Pull up to the location of the post where the card sensor is located. Hold access card to the sensor, wait for the gate to swing open against the post. When gate is fully open, promptly drive thru gate area and past the reflectors/signs.

5. Exiting:

Pass by the exit sensor location marked by yellow post/sign at 8-10 MPH, gate will commence to open as you approach the blue reflector. Wait for gate to swing open against the post, then promptly pass thru the gate area and complete your exit.

Member and/or authorized user activating the entry or exit sensor first has the right of way and others shall yield. When necessary, waiting members and/or authorized user shall move their vehicles to permit the activating member or authorized user safe pass thru.
