Minutes were read, distributed and accepted as written.

Financial report was distributed and accepted as presented.

Membership – active membership stands at 548 going into December.

President discussion – as has been the case for a number of years those who join at the October meeting or later will receive November and December as part of their next year membership.

Life membership changes tabled.

Rendezvousers – After significant discussion – Rendezvousers will be invited back only as part of a planned event. They will not be able to use our facility as a camp site. At Least one of their group has to become a member. When involved in planned events they will be the only shooters as part of demonstrations of the firearms. They will have to take the range safety course. The group will be invited to the next meeting to discuss our expectations as well as theirs.

Nathan Wenning and Bob Meihls presented the recently revised Range Rules for trustee review. Two changes were recommended. Trustees changed the definition of rapid fire. The Range Rules will now say no faster than one per second, revised from one every two seconds. And, the hours of operation of the ranges were changed to 9 PM or sunset whichever comes first. The amended rules passed unanimously.

Discussion was conducted on the status of Dr Aaron Pruitt who has failed to adhere to the stipulations set forth at the first meeting with the range committee following the range situation in August. Per the procedures set forth in the range rules the trustees voted to revoke all club privileges until contact is made with either Bob Meihls or Nathan Wenning. He was given till year end to comply.

Trustees also voted to buy two fire rings made by Davis Welding to be placed at the rear shelter house and the burning area at the camp site. Once in place rules will be implemented enforcing those two locations as the only burning areas by members.
