

## **Mercer County Sportsmen's Association Rimfire League**

The MCSA is going to have the 22LR Rimfire League again this year. The Rimfire League will be held on the third Saturday of each month, beginning in May and ending in October. Registration will begin at 11am and shooting will start at noon.

There will be 3 classes:

- Youth group will be 9 years to 17 years all factory rifles
- Adult group 18 to 99+ years Factory Rifles
- Adult group 18 to 99+ years Unlimited

### **Equipment**

- Factory Rifles are those readily available with 500 or more produced a retail value of less than \$1,000.00. Bolt action, semi-automatic, single shot, and "AR Style" are welcome as long as they meet these requirements.
- Unlimited Rifles are any gun that does not fit in the above category.
- Factory ammunition only is permitted. There can be no alterations to ammunition.
- Any optics are permitted.
- Rests are allowed, however no one-piece rests are permitted. Two-piece rests are allowed, but they cannot be attached to each other. Bipods are permitted.

### **Procedure**

- Each target will be placed at 50 yards and will have 25 bullseyes. You will have 20 minutes to complete your target. The entry fee for each target will be \$5.00.

### **Earnings**

- Monthly meet winner per class will get \$10.00 and bragging rights, assuming that there are at least two shooters per class.
- The top three for the season, based on total points for the season per class, will receive:
  - o 1<sup>st</sup> – 25% of season fees
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> – 15% of season fees
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup> – 10% of season fees

### **New League Information**

The Mercer County Sportsmen's Association will be participating in and become a sanctioned event in the Auto Bench Rest Association (ABRA). We are in the process of finalizing the details, but we hope to have the details finished up before the Spring shooting league starts. The information we do have at this time is that the rules and procedures will be very similar to the MCSA Rimfire League. There are two age groups, youth from 7-16 and adults, which are 16 and over. There are four classes of guns available for entry. Those classes are unlimited semi-automatic outdoor, factory semi-automatic outdoor, outlaw heavy barrel bolt gun outdoor, and outlaw lite barrel bolt gun outdoor.
