Presidents Report

Milt said the 5 stand guys had an idea to make the stands semi permanent.

Milt read a letter from an anonymous person that explained how the original membership worked in reference to spousal and family members, (He believed the information was from 1942 membership document)

With discussion, it was determined the new Spousal Membership enhances the original membership.

Annette handed out a sample of the new membership application with spousal membership option, and list of 2021 trustees and officers to members present.
