Presidents report

The 7, 10, and 25 yard ranges have new wood and new rubber thanks to Adrian Wenning and Charlie Goettemoeller. They plan on repairing 100 and 50 yard ranges after gun season. Byrd's tree service will be here after Nov. 30 to take down trees and do trimming, depending on weather. After that they will have a work party to cut up the wood for firewood.

Nathan said he and Bob have been talking about adding another campsite at southend of camping area. We could use fire-ring from shelter house #2. With all the dirt hauled back there, Nathan was hoping Ben could arrange for the bulldozer to clear things up so we could possibly put in a 3rd campsite to the north.

Annette asked how to handle sending out club decals for people who renew online.

The dirt on the trap and skeet area is about ready to seed. He suggested waiting to spring to seed.

He talked to Annette before the meeting about worker members. He gave her the names of people who mowed.

Mark then said the backstops are covered with staples. He suggested using push pins instead of staples. He said he didn't know if we need to consider ricochet off the pins. Discussion followed about best way to attach targets.

It was decided to get the push pins, and small container to put them in All current staples need to be remove

It was decided to look at the increase, to make it effective in 2026.

Chris Weaver made motion to raise dues effective Jan 1, 2026 membership dues to \$100.00 spousal dues to \$75.00 Land Certificates to \$50.00

Mark Linn seconded the motion.

Motion passed.

Other Business
