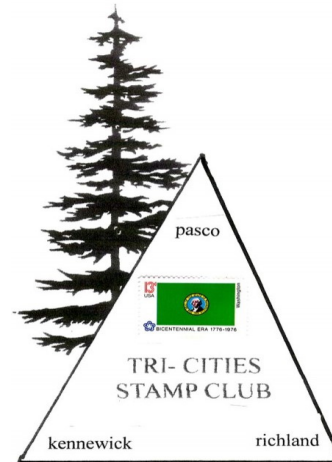

Zoom instructions

The following directions may differ depending on what you use.

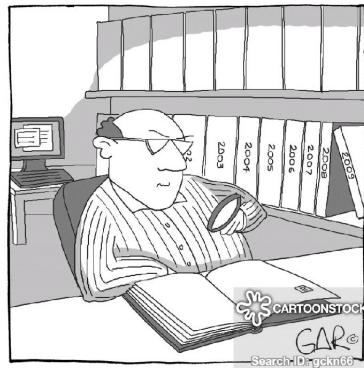
1. Turn on the audio on your computer.
2. Click the link in the email. No password is needed.
3. Click the Open Zoom Meetings button.
4. You will see all of the people who have signed in, including yourself.
5. Go to the upper, right corner of your icon . (It may show your name if you have attended Zoom meetings before.)
6. Click Mute to un-mute your audio, so that others can hear you speak.
7. Click the three dots next to it (...) and select Start Video and Rename to type in your name so that others can see your name and your picture.
