What can be Entered?

Who is Eligible to Enter?

All youth who are members of an active FFA Chapter or 4-H Club in the United States including 2022 graduates. Non-members of these youth groups may also apply.

Is this a group or individual contest?

It can be either. It can be a chapter/club entry or an entry by individual youths, Type of entry must be designated on the entry form.

How is the contest entered?

What supporting material will be required?
