Recognizing and preserving the heritage of Farmall and International Harvester tractors is one of the primary goals of the National IH Collectors Club. As we plan the 2022 Red Power Roundup, the Ohio Chapter 6 would like to draw attention to tractors that have a long legacy of serving the same family for multiple generations. To accomplish this, we invite any and all members who plan to display a tractor with such a history and allow us to recognize it in a special way.

The basic qualifications to be declared a “Heritage Tractor” are as follows:

- ❖ The tractor was manufactured prior to 1984 when International merged with Case.
- ❖ The tractor was purchased new and remained in the same family through the present day.
- ❖ Registration and needed information must be received by March 30, 2022*

There will be a professionally designed and printed display sign that will identify each tractor, its owner(s), and provide details about its history. There will also be a specially designated area for all Heritage Tractors to be displayed. Perks for owners of Heritage Tractors, in addition to being able to keep all the professionally prepared signage, will include special recognition during the daily parades, special photo effects for the yearbook, and a full color magnetic medallion for each tractor.

To register your Heritage Tractor, you need to do only two things.

1. Complete the **RED POWER HERITAGE TRACTOR REGISTRATION FORM**
2. Submit biographical information on the tractor. Details and suggestions regarding what to submit are included on the **RED POWER HERITAGE TRACTOR INFORMATION FORM**
3. Submit the above information no later than **March 30, 2022***

* Because considerable time will be required to prepare materials for printing and planning for display area size, it will not be possible to accept registrations after March 30, 2022.

2. You must be a member of International Harvester Collectors to display (IHC membership # required).
3. Displays are not to be used as personal transportation
4. Only time displays are to be moved is entering and leaving the shows, show book photos, daily parade or part of a demonstration
5. Speed limit is 5
6. Must be at least 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license to drive any display item.
7. No extra riders unless there is a factory seat installed
8. No steel wheel vehicle on the payment.
