- **IHC Chapter 6 and Clark County Fair Grounds are not responsible for lost and or stolen items Insurance:**

Vendor agrees to secure, at its own expense, a general liability insurance policy, with an insurance company authorized to do business in Ohio. Such policy shall name (A) Ohio Collectors of the International Harvester Collectors, Inc., (B) International Harvester Collectors, Inc., (C) Clark County Agricultural Society and (D) Clark County Commissioners additional insured parties against all claims for injury or death to persons and injury to or destruction of property and may not exclude products-completed operations hazard coverage. The minimum limits of said insurance policy shall be one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for bodily injury and property damage per occurrence, and two million dollars (\$2,000,000) in the aggregate, the terms of such coverage to coincide with the term of the show days. At least ten (10) days prior to commencement of the term of this Agreement, Vendor shall either furnish Rainprotection.net with a Certificate of Insurance signed by an agent authorized to sign for the issuing company or arrange to purchase the required insurance through the Rainprotection web page link on the Ohio Chapter 6 website. If said Certificate is not provided, Vendor shall not be allowed to participate in event.
