

### Feature to Field Checklist

*5 quick prompts to turn specs into copy that sells to public safety buyers*

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#### How to use this checklist

1. Pick one product feature.
2. Answer each question in the space provided.
3. Draft a single sentence that combines Outcome + Field Relevance.
4. Repeat for the next feature.

**Goal:** Replace “spec-sheet language” with copy a captain could repeat in a briefing.

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Prompt	Your Notes
<b>1. What shift-level problem does this feature remove?</b> (e.g., manual headcount, duplicate data entry)	
<b>2. How much time, money, or risk does that save?</b> (quantify if you can: minutes, dollars, percentage)	
<b>3. Who feels the benefit first?</b> (role/title: dispatcher, lieutenant, IT admin)	
<b>4. What bigger mission outcome does it support?</b> (reduced overtime, faster response, safer staff)	
<b>5. Say it in one breath, no jargon.</b> (Write the final benefit sentence here.)	

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**Fast Example (filled in)**

Prompt	Example Answer
Shift-level problem	Manual incident summaries
Time / money / risk	Saves ~45 mins per shift
First beneficiary	Patrol sergeant
Mission outcome	More cars on the street during peak hours
One-breath benefit sentence	“Auto-generated incident summaries put a sergeant back on patrol instead of behind a desk.”
