THREAT LEVEL: APOCALYPTIC

THREAT ASSESSMENT

01

Subject is assessed as an apocalyptic-level threat based on repeated field encounters and sustained engagement failures.

Primary threat vector is auditory mimicry. Subjects replicate human speech patterns to lure targets into close range. Mimicry includes distress calls, names, and basic commands. Effectiveness increases in low-light environments.

Subjects display erratic but purposeful movement. Engagement typically occurs after isolation of target. Multiple contacts indicate that subjects do not operate alone. Encounters escalate rapidly when one is present.

Standard engagement methods are unreliable. Withdrawal is recommended unless equipped with appropriate countermeasures.

PSYCHOLOGICAL PROFILE

02

Not applicable.

Behaviour is consistent with predatory instinct supported by heightened sensory input. Subjects demonstrate awareness beyond visual range, reacting to sound and movement with high accuracy.

Field observations indicate strong aversion to high-intensity light and concentrated chemical or organic odours. Exposure disrupts approach patterns and may force withdrawal.

No evidence of empathy, restraint, or higher reasoning. Behaviour does not align with known human or animal models.

ENCOUNTER HISTORY

03

Initial encounters occurred during Eurussian containment operations in the Western Territories following the Sickness outbreak.

Military units deployed to construct coastal barrier and inland outposts reported increasing disappearances, followed by confirmed hostile contact. Construction halted before completion. Containment line remains incomplete.

Outposts recovered post-abandonment show evidence of internal sealing procedures. Multiple sites contain remains of both infected and uninfected personnel. Full scale of spread remains unconfirmed.

SPECIALIST CAPABILITIES

- > Extreme close-quarters lethality
- > Auditory mimicry (primary hunting method)
- > Unpredictable movement patterns
- > Enhanced low-light operation
- > High resilience to conventional weapons
