






Lesson 1: Study

In 2020, the poverty rate for the world was 10.9%. This means that one in ten children didn't have reliable access to food in 2019. In 2020 a global pandemic swept around the world, halting economies and creating an even greater need for food. People are hungry for physical nourishment and for connection to each other.

Hear now the word of the Lord from the gospel of Matthew chapter twenty-five verses thirty-five through forty:

35 For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, 36 I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.' 37 "Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? 38 When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? 39 When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?' 40 "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.'

There's a helplessness to understanding that, while we live our lives, there are others who are struggling every day to feed their families. Jesus in the book of Matthew is asking his disciples to imagine him in the faces of all the people they encounter who are in need. Whether they are in need of physical food and water or nourishment for their souls, Jesus is asking his disciples never to forget those who are in need.

Jesus is asking us to do the same, even when it is hard to imagine and even when we don't know how to help.




REFLECTION
