Wisconsin Desert Horse Association hosted Meet An Arabian Horse Day event at our WDHA Festival AVS Show on September 21, 2019. WDHA FUTURITY AND MATURITY PROGRAMS

The Wisconsin Desert Horse Association has had a Futurity program since its founding in 1963. It has gone through a number of changes over the years, all of them destined to reward people willing to invest in the futures of their breeding choices.

Originally a halter futurity only, the club added Futurity Performance in the late 1980s, about the same time WDHA joined the MidAmerica Arabian Breeders group to provide a common venue for competition and the awarding of handsome cash paybacks. I still remember the first combined show, when 17 fillies were featured in the WDHA yearling filly class. It was a very impressive class...and since payouts were made to the top five only, the cash awards were impressive, even down to fifth place.

The MidAmerica program changed venues about 15 years ago and disbanded entirely about 10 years ago. When MAAB moved to another club association, WDHA added its Futurity and Maturity classes to its Open Show; and to provide additional funds to make participation worthwhile, conducts a number of raffles and silent auctions to provide additional funds to replace the drop in nomination fees because breedings are down.

The last few years, an additional \$100 per futurity class has been added to the paybacks, as well as the added money from raffles, etc. Consequently, entries in this year's futurity classes took home much more money than they spent in nomination fees.

Nominations are up slightly over the last few years; but paybacks will remain handsome as long as the club continues to provide added money... which it will in support of its members who continue to promote the breed with their breeding choices.

The deadline for mare nominations and foal renominations without penalty is December 31. A nom/renom form is available in this issue of the newsletter as well as online at the club website. Complete rules governing the program are also available at wdhaarabian.com.
